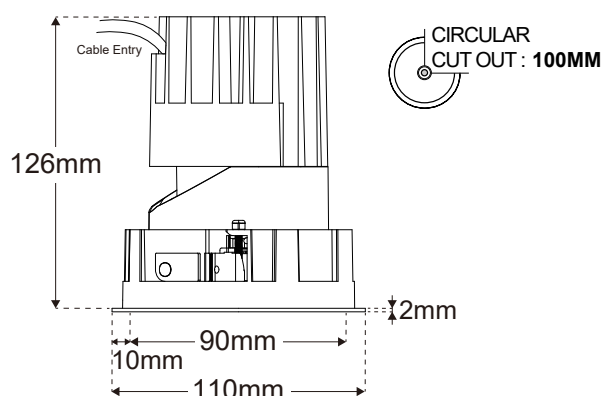

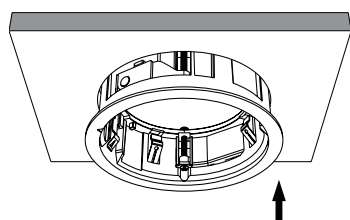


Instructions

Please ensure the power supply is fully switched off before carrying out any installation work.

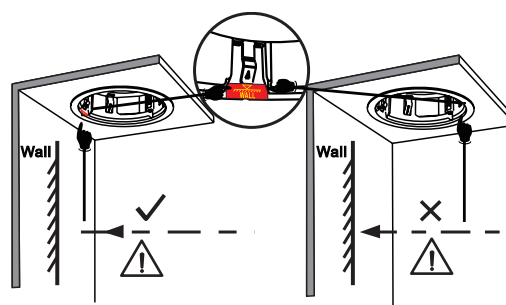
Step 1 – Insert the Luminaire Outer Ring

Check that the ceiling cut-out matches the required size, and ensure the surrounding surface is clean and free from debris. Position the outer ring of the luminaire into the ceiling cut-out.



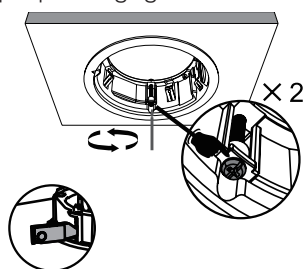
Step 2 – Luminaire Outer Ring Position

Ensure the wall-marking indicator faces toward the wall.



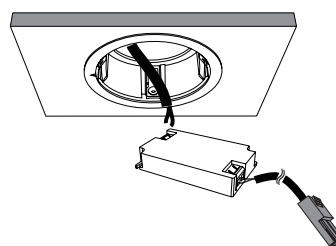
Step 3 – Secure with Screws

Tighten the two mounting screws to lock the luminaire outer ring frame securely into place. A clear "click" should indicate proper engagement.



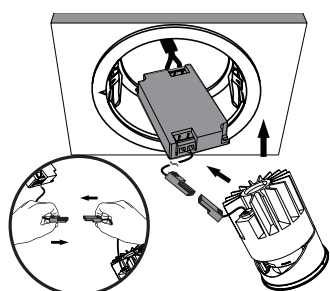
Step 4 – Connect the Mains Supply

Pass the mains cable through the opening and connect the driver wiring to the mains supply in accordance with all relevant wiring regulations.



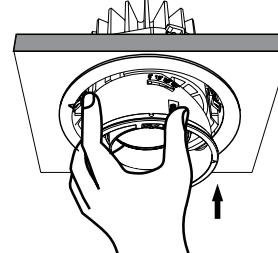
Step 5 – Connect the Driver to the Luminaire

Attach the luminaire connector to the LED driver, ensuring the connection is firm and fully secured.



Step 6 – Position the Driver and Insert the Luminaire

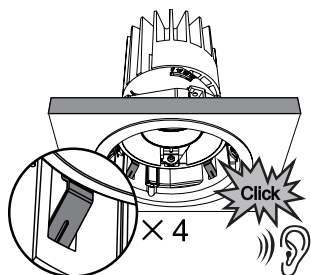
Feed the LED driver through the ceiling cut-out and position it safely within the ceiling void, ensuring no cables are pinched or overstretched. Insert the luminaire into the ceiling cut-out.

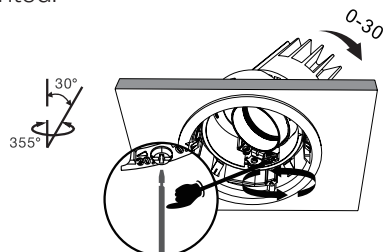
Step 7 – Fix the Unit in Place

The fixture should engage with a clear click when correctly secured.



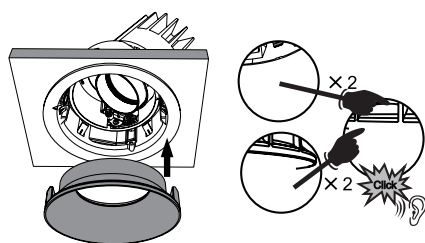
Step 8 – Adjust the Light

Tilt or rotate the light module as required to suit your application. Screw the product in position to ensure it is firmly mounted.



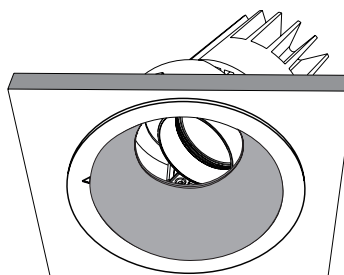
Step 9 – Refit the Bezel

Align the bezel with the front of the fixture and push it back into place. Ensure it locks securely and sits flush with the ceiling.

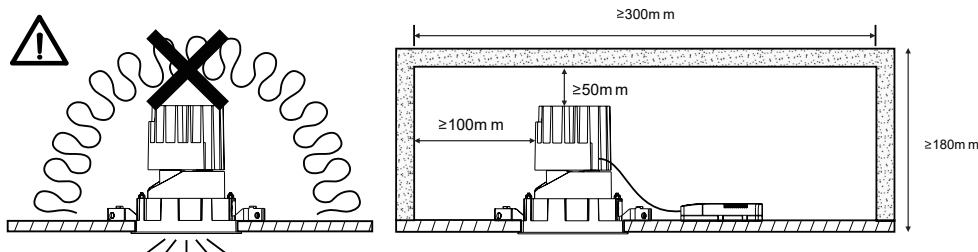


Step 10 - Restore Power

Check that the installation is secure, then switch the mains power back on and verify correct operation.



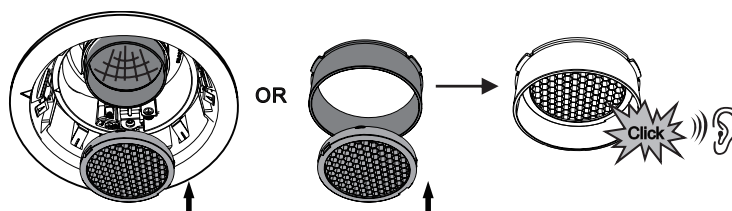
Maintenance



- Do not cover the luminaire or its driver with insulation.
- Maintain a minimum clearance:
 - ≥50 mm above the luminaire.
 - ≥100 mm from nearby objects or heat-sensitive materials.
- Ensure the void depth meets the manufacturer's requirements for safe airflow and heat dissipation.

Honeycombe Louvre

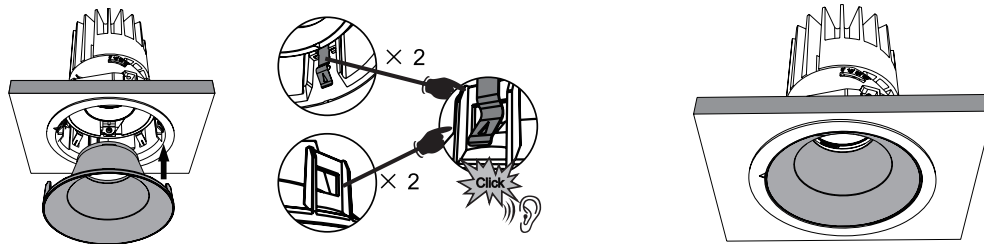
(Optional Accessory – Ordered Separately)



- Insert the honeycomb louvre into the front of the luminaire or into the accessory ring, depending on the configuration.
- Push the louvre firmly into place until it locks with an audible click.

Deep Recessed Reflector

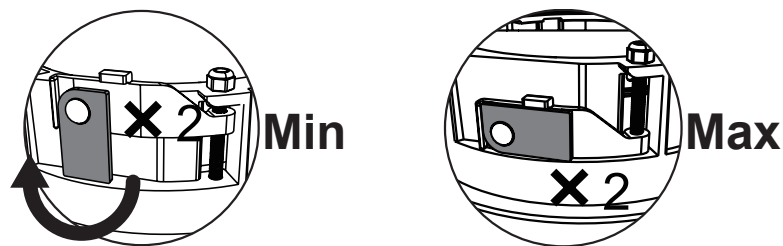
(Optional Accessory – Ordered Separately)



- Position the deep recessed reflector underneath the luminaire and align it with the mounting points.
- Secure the reflector by tightening the two fixing clips on each side until they click into place.
- Check that the reflector is fully seated and sits flush with the luminaire front.

Wall Wash Reflector

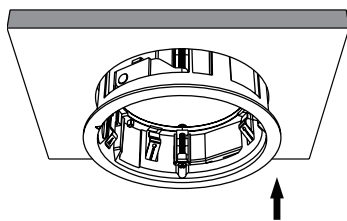
(Optional Accessory – Ordered Separately)

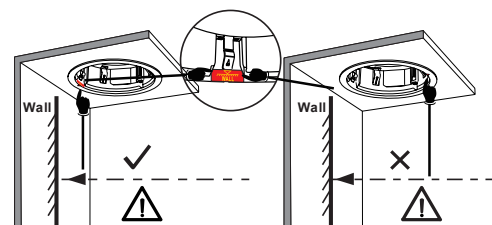
Step 1 – Insert the Luminaire Outer Ring

Check that the ceiling cut-out matches the required size, and ensure the surrounding surface is clean and free from debris. Position the outer ring of the luminaire into the ceiling cut-out.



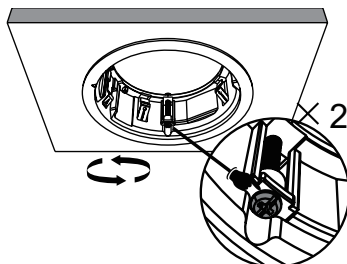
Step 2 – Align the Wall-Wash Orientation

Ensure the wall-marking indicator on the luminaire faces toward the wall to be illuminated.



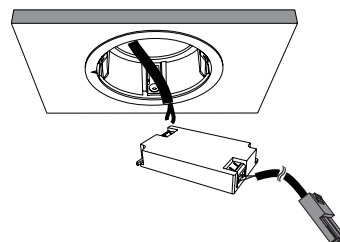
Step 3 – Secure with Screws

Tighten the two mounting screws to lock the luminaire outer ring securely into place. A clear “click” should indicate proper engagement.



Step 4 – Connect the Mains Supply

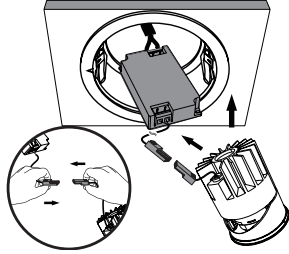
Pass the mains cable through the cut-out and connect the driver wiring to the mains supply in accordance with all relevant electrical regulations.

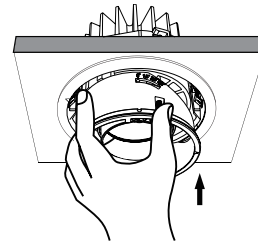
Step 5 – Connect the Driver to the Luminaire

Attach the luminaire connector to the LED driver, ensuring the connection is firm and fully secured.



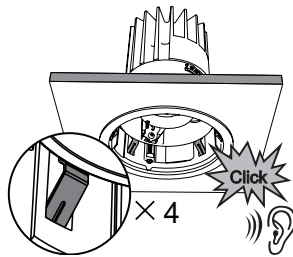
Step 6 – Position the Driver and Insert the Luminaire

Feed the driver into the ceiling void and position it safely, ensuring no cables are pinched or overstretched. Insert the luminaire body into the outer ring.



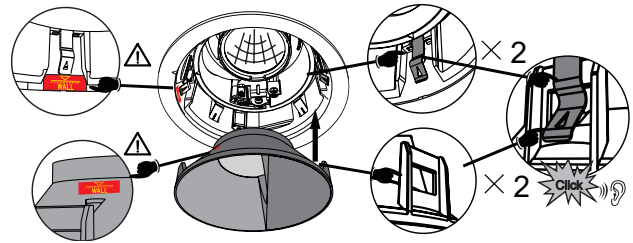
Step 7 – Lock the Unit in Place

Press the luminaire upward until it clicks securely into the mounting ring. Verify that all four locking clips are fully engaged.

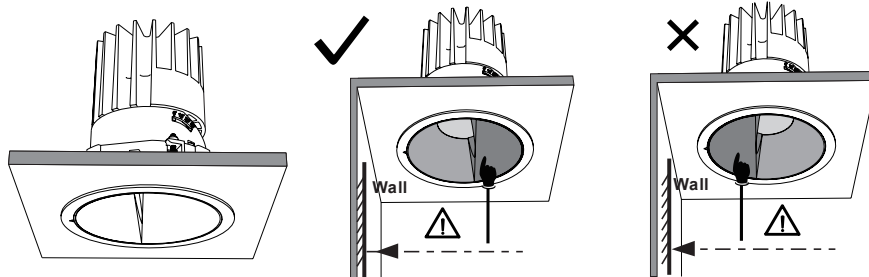


Step 8 – Install the Wall Wash Reflector

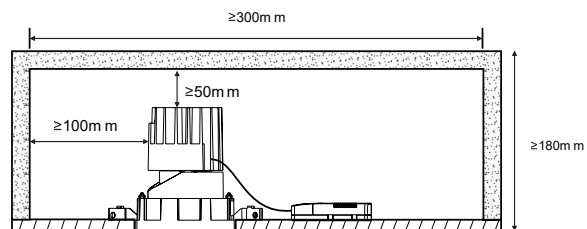
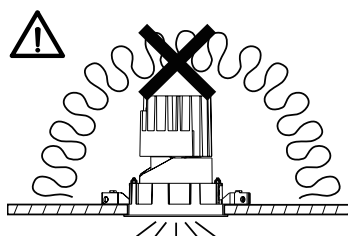
Position the wall-wash reflector inside the luminaire and secure the reflector by tightening the two fixing clips on each side until they click into place.



Maintenance



- Check that the reflector opening faces directly toward the wall to be illuminated.
- A forward-facing orientation ensures the correct wall-wash effect.
- Do not install the reflector facing away from the wall, as this will result in incorrect lighting distribution.



- Do not cover the luminaire or its driver with insulation.
- Maintain a minimum clearance:
 - ≥50 mm above the luminaire.
 - ≥100 mm from nearby objects or heat-sensitive materials.
- Ensure the void depth meets the manufacturer's requirements for safe airflow and heat dissipation.
